Here at Care Centre, we take great pride in the quality of the care we provide: a warm, friendly and sociable environment, where our residents' health and happiness sits at the heart of everything we do.

Since 1994, our Home has been integral to life in the local community and we have built a reputation for providing excellent care for the elderly, the disabled and those living with dementia.

The Home's uniqueness comes from its three courts, all differing in the types of care they offer. Wellington Court provides complex disability care for both men and women of all ages whilst Wrekin Court provides various types of care for the elderly, including convalescence, palliative care and specialist dementia care. Ercall Court, affiliated to the Care Centre, is just a short walk from the Home and with only 11 bedrooms, it provides specialist dementia care in a home from home environment.

Highly trained care teams go the extra mile every day to ensure residents are well looked after and are able to continue living fulfilling lives, where their dignity is respected and independence nurtured.



The Way We Care

Dementia Care

Our specialist dementia care is captured through our Cedar Philosophy, which looks holistically at each person, their wellbeing and nursing needs. We create a sense of belonging in a calm and caring environment, enabling residents live to their own timescales.



Complex Care

Our teams deliver the highest standards of care for complex symptoms, from brain injuries to Parkinson's disease. They are also able to provide core medical interventions to minimise admission to acute hospital where relevant.



Palliative Care

Our palliative care aims to improve and enhance the quality of life for those living with long term illnesses and life limiting conditions. Our nurses and carers are trained within the National Gold Standards Framework (GSF) which ensures they provide outstanding clinical and emotional end of life care.



Disability Care

We don't let disability define a person. Working closely with Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) and Social Services, we provide those with severe disabilities the care they need in comforting surroundings. Our staff are specially trained and residents are encouraged to lead fulfilling lives, interacting within the Home and where possible, developing and maximising their independence.



Elderly Care

Our later life care respects the dignity, privacy and independence of every resident and can be every bit as fulfilling, sociable and enjoyable as living at home.

Getting to Know You






